#### One or Two Authors

#### 3 or more authors

Burns, Robert, et al. *Poetry*. T.C. and E.C. Jack, 1896.

### Articles (databases or newspaper/journal/magazine websites)

Lastname, First Name. "Title of Article." Title of Periodical, Publisher, Publication Date, URL. Date of access.

#### Online newspaper/website article

Author, A. A. (Year, Month Date). *Title of page*. Site name. URL

Lastname, First Name. "Title of Article." Title of Periodical, volume number, issue number, Year of Publication, pp. pages. Database Name, DOI or URL. Date of access.

### Webpages (include as much information as possible)

Editor, author, or compiler name (if available). "Title of Article." Name of Site. Version number. Name of institution/organization affiliated with the site (sponsor or publisher), date of resource creation (if available), URL, DOI, or permalink. Date of access.

# In-Text Citations

## **Short Quotation (fewer than 40 words)**

A direct quote is a word for word copy of source material. Enclose the quote in quotation marks. Include the author's last name and date of publication.

### *Example*

"Have your resume with you while completing the application so all information will be accurate and consistent" (Morris 14).

## **Long Quotations (more than 40 words)**

The block quote is used for direct quotations that are longer than 40 words. Do not use quotation marks. Indent the entire quote 1 inch.

### *Example*

The actual interview is as much about you evaluating the institution and people as they evaluate you. You can have an awesome interview, but just not feel a "click". It is absolutely acceptable to ask for time to consider if you are offered the position at the interview. (Morris, 2018, p.32).

## **Paraphrase**

A paraphrase is a quotation rewritten in your own words. Both require citations. Include the author's last name and the page number.

### *Example*

It is common to be nervous about interviews but if the candidate prepares the result will be a success (Morris 32).
